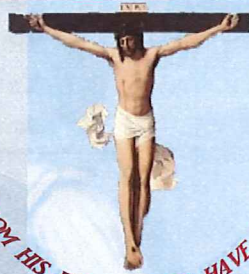

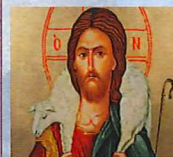

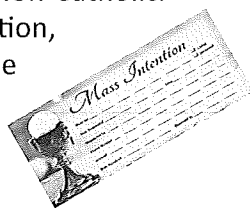

## Spiritual but not religious

In RCIA class the other night we talked about the necessity of the Church and why it is essential for salvation. One of the popular ideas in our world is, "I'm spiritual but not religious." This usually means that I follow God, but I don't go to church. We do not believe in this as Catholics. We believe that to follow Jesus, we must be active and faithfully coming to his Church that he established. To follow Christ, we must abide by the standards that he has given: going to mass every Sunday and Holy days of Obligation, going to confession, and continuing to learn the faith. It is not just about me and Jesus, but it is about all of us striving together to encourage and help one another along this journey to heaven.

I think that the reason why many want to be spiritual but not religious is that it is easier. Jesus calls us to live by a high standard that he gives to us through his Church. He calls us to great heights because he has created us for greatness, for sainthood. This is hard. These demands challenge us and draw us to places that are uncomfortable, yet that is where we find the greatest graces. These standards of the Church are not meant to make it more difficult, but to protect us from the dangers of the world. It is in the Church that we have safety.

I imagine that it is like going down a river with rapids. When we are in the Church, we are in the safety of the white-water raft. It is still going to be rough and there will be times when we must paddle like mad, but we are safe there. When we try to go down the river without the raft (aka the Church), we run the risk of being seriously injured or perishing among the rapids and the rocks.

"For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men" (1 Cor 1:25). The Wisdom of God has given us the Church to be our sure means to get to heaven. There are many rapids, rocks, and dangers in this world. When we try to face them alone, outside the Church, we lose the protection of the raft and the help of the people paddling alongside us.
