Beginning this year, our U.S. Catholic Church will be launching a Eucharistic revival initiative that will take us into the year 2024. This initiative seeks to bring Catholics to the heart and soul of the Church, namely the True Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. While Catholics worldwide are tending more to live their faith outside of the Church, or outside of mass, those who remain have a deep faith in Christ's True Presence in the Eucharist. How do we effectively transmit that faith which can hold us into the Body of Christ? How can the Church remain believing and even grow in our encounter with Christ in the Eucharist? This flier is the first of more to come from our U.S. Bishops, which will lay out the path ahead.
