Pictured aside: the official traveling relic of the blood of St. John Paul II, coming to our Diocese. The relic is held in a beautiful reliquary shaped like the Book of the Gospels, whose pages blew and flapped in the wind when laid on John Paul's coffin at his funeral Mass on April 8, 2005. The relic of his blood comes from his last hospitalization in Rome in 2005 and miraculously, is still liquefied.

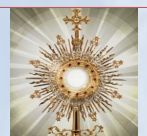
