

# Join the Church in 24 Hours of Eucharistic Adoration

## in Spiritual preparation for Easter



Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament allows us to spend time with Jesus Christ in his Eucharistic presence. Our Catholic faith acknowledges that Christ is truly and substantially present in the form of the bread consecrated during mass. This means that the whole person of Christ is truly there-His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. When the Church places Christ in the monstrance to be displayed, we truly look upon the body of Him, who suffered for our sins, was nailed to a cross, who died, and was raised from the dead to remain with us forever. Because this Holy Week celebrates the Salvation which Christ won for us through his Body, it is fitting that we come to adore His Body still present to us in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

### How do I pass the time during Eucharistic Adoration?

We adore Christ’s Body and Blood because he already has in his mind the particular grace needed in one’s life. He already knows your every thought and struggle. He knows them more perfectly than you do. Because he knows you so perfectly and possesses the perfect gift of grace for you, come and kneel before him and let him lead the encounter. Let him lead the time. Let him lead your soul.

Just like at mass, the people begin with a humble acknowledgement of unworthiness to be in the presence of their Creator. Without taking up too much of the time, ask Christ for a total purification of your mind, your heart, and your soul. “Blessed are the clean of heart, for they shall see God.”

Meditate, or focus your mind, on the gift of God, who is there on the altar. Consider the Last Supper, when Christ gave his Eucharistic Body to the Church. Recall how he was killed and sacrificed like a lamb so that he might become our food. Recount the story of the resurrection of his Body, and Christ’s pledge that he will always remain with his Church. You may want to bring your bible and read the account of the passion and resurrection. Ask Jesus to deepen your faith and understanding of this gift before your eyes on the altar.

Give sufficient time to simply listen for Christ to inspire thoughts, insights, wisdom, or counsel in you. The experience is like when one listens super-intently in trying to discover the source of a noise. We strain ourselves and concentrate on the silence and the stillness, so that the holy whispers of God can be heard in our hearts. Wait for his Word.

Give thanks to God for coming to you in the Blessed Sacrament and ask him for the strength to live by the grace he gave you.
