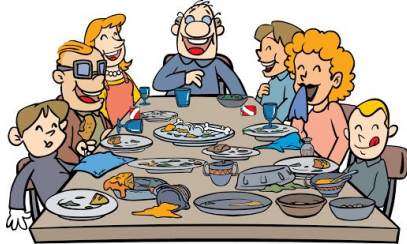
FACILITY EVENTS COORDINATOR POSITION
