## **Eucharistic Processions**

The Feast of Corpus Christi this year will mark the end of the three-year Eucharistic Revival in the United States. The last two years we have done a Eucharistic Procession in Winner around the grounds of the Church. This year I would like to do a procession at Saint Isidore's in Colome. The procession will be on Sunday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Then after the procession will be lunch downstairs in the Church.

Some people may be wondering that if Corpus Christi is on Sunday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> this year, why are we having the procession on June 15<sup>th</sup>. The answer for that is simple. Bishop Bullock is having a Eucharistic Procession in Rapid City from the Cathedral to the park to close out the Eucharistic Revival. I want to make it possible for those who want to go to Rapid City for that procession, but I still want to do one with my people here in the parishes.
