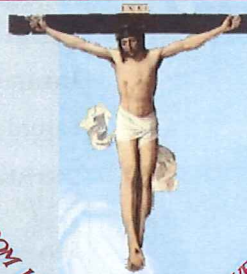

A Safe Environment for Children and Young People

The Catholic Diocese of Rapid City is firmly committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for our children and young people. To report allegations of sexual abuse by church personnel, contact Victim Assistance Coordinator Irene Lee.

In accordance with diocesan policy, all allegations of sexual misconduct involving children or young people by priests, deacons, lay employees, or volunteers serving the Diocese of Rapid City will be investigated.

Eucharistic Processions

The Feast of Corpus Christi this year will mark the end of the three-year Eucharistic Revival in the United States. The last two years we have done a Eucharistic Procession in Winner around the grounds of the Church. This year I would like to do a procession at Saint Isidore's in Colome. The procession will be on Sunday, June 15th. Then after the procession will be lunch downstairs in the Church.

The mass schedule will be changed for that Sunday, June 15 only, to make this procession possible. The mass at Immaculate Conception will be at 8:30 am, and the mass at Saint Isidore will be at 10:30 am with the Procession to follow mass.

Everyone is welcome to come join in. If any of our first communicants want to join in the procession, I invite them to wear their first communion outfits. They would be able to process right behind the canopy as we process, or with their families.

Some people may be wondering that if Corpus Christi is on Sunday, June 22nd this year, why are we having the procession on June 15th. The answer for that is simple. Bishop Bullock is having a Eucharistic Procession in Rapid City from the Cathedral to the park to close out the Eucharistic Revival. I want to make it possible for those who want to go to Rapid City for that procession, but I still want to do one with my people here in the parishes.
