

Spread the word to vote **No on Amendment G**

Some of you may find politics as frustrating as I, or some of you may love it. Either way, they play a big impact in our state and nation. An important one coming up in November on the SD ballot is Amendment G. In short, this amendment seeks to enshrine abortion in the SD constitution. This is a grave evil that we do not want here.

This amendment is sold to everyone as promoting freedom; rather it promotes death. If this amendment passes, then it will throw out all the legislation that SD has passed to help protect women and their unborn children. Abortion is illegal in South Dakota because we believe that every life is sacred and important. If this amendment passes, then our state would be saying that only some lives matter. This amendment would also allow for abortion up to birth.

The people who are trying to get this amendment passed will say that it is necessary for the protection of women and their rights. They will even say that our current laws prevent women from receiving treatment for life-threatening complications such as an ectopic pregnancy. This is a blatant lie! 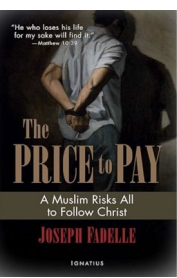

Note: If you do not manually sign out of FORMED, you will remain perpetually logged in, so that the next time you visit FORMED on that computer, you begin enjoying content. to bookmark the site to make it even easier to get back to FORMED.

Formed can be accessed on almost any platform including Android (Play Store), IOS (Apple App Store), web browser, Roku, Chromecast, FireTV and AppleTV.
