



The Father always keeps his promises

We use the word “hope” a great deal in our everyday vocabulary. We speak about how we hope that the Lord will bless our land with much needed rain. We hope that cattle and feed prices will help to cover the costs that we incurred in this last year’s efforts to get them to market. Some of us even say that we hope that the wind won’t blow. All these examples use this word “hope” as wishful thinking. They are things that we want but we have no control over them nor influence to make them happen or not. The wind will blow whether we want it to or not (this is a reality of the plains). It is important to note that when we speak about the Catholic virtue of hope, we are talking about something more than wishful thinking.

“And without faith it is impossible to please God. For whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him” (Hebrews 11:6). This statement is the summary of the second reading. That Abraham believed that God not only had the power to keep the promises that he had made, but he also had the sure knowledge that God would keep his promises. This is the virtue of hope. That we have confidence that the one who made the promise will keep his promises and that he has the power to do so. So, our virtue of hope is not a wishful thinking or wanting, but a confidence placed in the one who made the promise of eternal life to us.

When Jesus calls us to be prepared for him, and to wait for his coming. When he calls us to place our focus on him and to disregard the pleasures and temptations of this world. We can do so, knowing confidently that God exists and that he rewards those who seek him. “What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man conceived, what God has prepared for those who love him” (1 Cor 2:9).

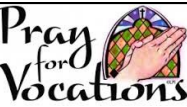
