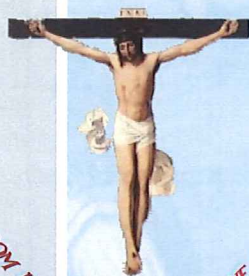

Cor ad Cor (Heart speaks to Heart)

Some of you may have seen the flyers or posters for the program “Cor ad cor” which means “Heart speaks to heart.” You may be asking what is it and who is it for. The short answer of who is it for, it is for anyone who is looking to deepen his or her spiritual life and life of prayer.

The Cor ad cor program is a weekly small group of either only men or only women. It teaches you how to deepen your prayer life by praying through the spiritual exercises of Saint Ignatius of Loyola. The spiritual exercises is a 30 day retreat that Ignatius created for those discerning and seeking to grow in their spiritual life. The Cor ad cor program takes that 30-day retreat and breaks it up over a little over 30 weeks. They meet either in person or over zoom depending on where the leader and people of the small group live.

I would highly encourage anyone who wants to grow in their prayer life to look into this program. It is a great help and blessing for teaching you how to deepen your daily prayer life with the Lord.
