

## God is Trustworthy

“For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil” (Gen 3:5). This is the lie that began it all. The one told by the ancient dragon, the father of lies, to Eve in the garden. We can hear the cunning undertone, “God is holding out on you” and ultimately, “God cannot be trusted to give you what you need.” This is the lie that our first parents swallowed whole, and we have been caught by it ever since.

Peter wrestles against this lie in asking Jesus to let him walk on the water, and I firmly believe that Jesus wants Peter to ask for this very thing. The Lord answers his request and Peter begins walking on the water amid the waves and the wind. Peter begins to sink when he loses sight that Jesus has called him onto the water. Peter begins to doubt that Jesus will remain faithful to his word because he becomes focused on the waves and the force of the wind. So, he begins to sink, yet Peter cries out to the Lord. Jesus saves him from the waves of water and doubt that threaten to drown him. Peter shows us that Jesus NEVER leads us to a place of vulnerability to abandon us. If Peter would not have sunk, would the two of them walked to the other shore? I wonder if he would not have called all the disciples to leave the boat and walk with him across the water to the shore. (Since the scriptures don't tell us, I guess we will never know.)

Why do we wait in the boat? What holds us back from stepping out onto the water with Jesus? He has called us to step forth to him, to boldly leave all behind to walk to him. I think that we can hide in the boat like Adam and Eve did after the fall. We can be afraid to step to Jesus because we see that we are weak and vulnerable. We can draw back because we are afraid of what he may ask of us if we walk out on the water to him. However, we need not fear the wind, the waves, or our own vulnerability. God is trustworthy, and he calls us from our boat to show us that he calls us to abundant life with him.
