AEDS In Our Parish

Sudden cardiac arrest is one of the leading causes of death in the U.S. Over 350,000 people will suffer from sudden cardiac arrest this year . It can happen to anyone, anytime, anywhere and at any age. An AED is the only effective treatment for restoring a regular heart rhythm during sudden cardiac arrest and is an easy to operate tool for someone with no medical background.

What is an AED?

AED stands for Automated External Defibrillator. It is a medical device that analyzes the heart's rhythm. If necessary, it delivers an electrical shock, known as defibrillation, which helps the heart re-establish an effective rhythm. Sudden cardiac arrest can be treated most effectively with a combination of CPR and early defibrillation.

With the number of individuals that attend Immaculate Conception, and with the great number of events hosted at St. Mary's hall, we feel purchasing two AEDs is an important proactive step for our parishioners and community. The total cost for two AEDs with cabinets is \$2,000. We would gladly welcome any donations for this investment.
