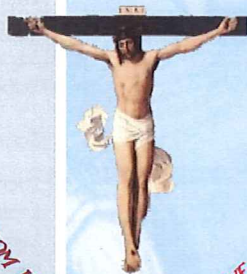

Surplus or Everything

“Jesus sat down opposite the treasury and observed how the crowd put money into the treasury. Many rich people put in large sums. A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents. Calling his disciples to himself, he said to them, ‘Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood. (Mk 12:41-44)’”

I wrote last week that God is never out done in generosity. That as we give ourselves to him through making gifts of ourselves through our time, talent, and treasure, that he pours out his blessings upon us. It does not mean that there will not be hardships, but God is never outdone in generosity. Yet, the nagging thought at the back of my mind was do I give of my surplus or do I give everything? The widow in that passage of St. Mark’s gospel is praised because she gave everything that she had. The bold challenge that kept coming to my mind was do I offer everything to the Lord or just from my surplus.

I don’t know if it is just my faulty memory, or if this is the message that I actually heard growing up. I remember hearing numerous times, “we all have time, talent, or treasure, and we give from what we have.” That often stuck in my mind as give from the one that you have the most abundance in. So, if you had more time but less treasure, you gave of your time but did not have to give of your treasure. I find that to be giving only of my surplus in my life. However, I offer a challenge, if you are feeling bold. What if we were to offer from all three. I am not saying that you give everything of all three, that would seem to be imprudent unless you desire to become a Franciscan.

I had mentioned tithing in a true example in last week’s bulletin page, with a little humor for flavor. Giving a tithe is a portion (usually in the strict sense a tenth) back to the Lord in gratitude. In the old Testament, the Israelites would give a tithe of their produce of the land and livestock. It was recognizing that everything came as a gift from God, and they offered that portion back to him in thanksgiving. However, are we willing to give a portion of what we have of each? The treasure example is easier to show the math because if I am not in the practice of giving, because money is tight, a full tenth may be a lot. But if I were so bold, what if I started with 2 or 3 percent. If I made 100 dollars that week, three percent would be giving three dollars back to the Lord (for easy math).

The gifts of time and talent I think usually go hand in hand. In the case of time do I carve out time during the week for prayer outside of going to weekly Sunday mass? When we think of talent, have we ever asked Jesus, “what talents and gifts have you given to me to build up the kingdom of God?” Maybe the Lord has blessed you with talents that can help to build up the liturgy at mass in some way. If you help with a ministry at mass, do I seek to invite others to help as well? I guarantee that Jesus has given talents to you to fulfill the role that he has entrusted specifically to you. There may be other talents outside of the liturgy, but the generosity of people helps to enrich our liturgies and worship of God.

I find in my own life that I am working to be more generous to the Father from all three. It may be the case that I am the only one who thought that I heard “or” instead of “and” with regards to time, talent, and treasure. If we believe that God is not out done in generosity, then can we be bold enough to give back to him a portion from all three remembering that everything that we have is a gift from him. God bless.
