

24TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

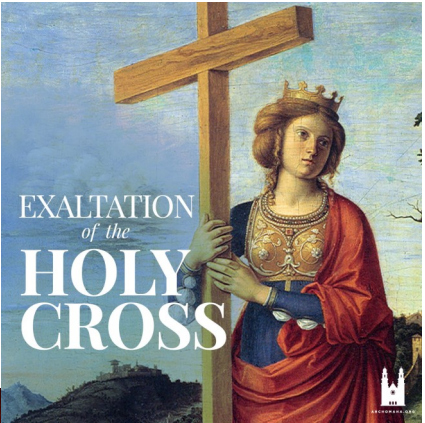
“He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days. He spoke this openly. Then Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. At this he turned around and, looking at his disciples, rebuked Peter and said, “Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do.”



Our Lord’s harsh and immediate response to Peter was meant to unmask Satan’s corruptive influence at work in the minds of his disciples, most notably, Peter’s. What was this corruption? Specifically, Peter would not accept Christ’s mission to suffer and die on the cross. If Peter runs from the mere hint of Christ’s suffering, surely he would run in shame when his Lord would be lifted up on the cross. And he did. Peter lied, betrayed his friendship with Christ, cursed at the accusation that he belonged to his company of followers, and scurried off into the night to hide. His human way of thinking was the easy pathway for Satan’s deceit to enter Peter. After all, why should the Master suffer? Can anything good come of suffering? How could I let this happen to him? Surely he would work a miracle to spare his own life. Satan uses our human way of thinking to turn us away from the Divine Wisdom of the cross. In God’s way of thinking, the cross decisively defeated Satan’s power over man. The shackles of sin are broken and death no longer has power over us. The cross is not meant to be fled, but sought out each day. ‘Like the deer that yearns for flowing streams, so my soul is searching.’ Only in the Wisdom of God is found this wondrous and tranquil oasis. The suffering of the Lord has lightened our burden. His wounds are opened to receive our sins. He was fastened to a tree that our fetters might be unfastened. He expired that we may be resuscitated.


