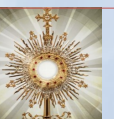

Children and Young People

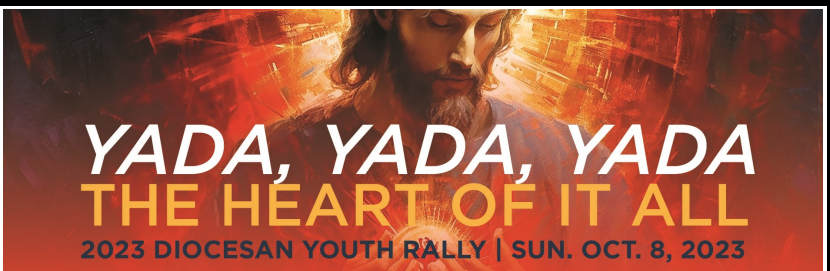

Alleged victims are advised of their right to report alleged abuse to civil authorities.
