Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"As we have all seen and heard in recent weeks, the many reports and scenes of war and violence, especially in the Middle East ... How can you and I participate in any peacemaking process? I would ask our Catholic community, and all others concerned about these situations, to pray for peace and to support diplomatic efforts aimed at dialogue and reconciliation. This can be done in personal prayers and in the Prayers of the Faithful at Mass. But all of us must take an active part in praying for peace. It is a small way in which we can participate in building just, peaceful and civil societies around the world. We should never underestimate the power of prayer. It is Christ's peace for which we are asking. *"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid"* (Jn 14:27). As the body of Christ, through prayer, together we might help open our world to God's gift of peace."
