Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On Monday, I received a letter from Archbishop José Gomez, President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). He wrote,

*As a result of Hurricane Ian's havoc – first across Cuba and the Dominican Republic and then the southeast US starting in Florida – lives have been lost and many Church properties, along with homes and businesses, have been severely damaged or destroyed. This followed the impact of Hurricane Fiona, which caused devastation across Puerto Rico and other parts of the Caribbean.*

*Our partners at Catholic Charities USA, along with their local agencies, are hard at work providing humanitarian relief and will be with communities over their extended recovery. Likewise, Catholic Relief Services and its local partners are responding with food, water, and sanitation assistance, and will eventually assist with the repair and rebuilding of homes.*

As recent years have demonstrated, we can expect more volatile weather and potential for more natural disasters before this season ends. The USCCB Office for National Collections have asked us to make a special appeal for the **Bishops Emergency Disaster Fund** to support the efforts of Catholic Charities USA and/or Catholic Relief Services, the official relief agencies of the U.S. Catholic Church, as they and their local agencies respond to immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter and medical care, as well as aid in long-term rebuilding and recovery efforts. The collection will also support the USCCB in providing for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church in affected areas. Funds will be used in response to Hurricane Fiona and to replenish the Fund to provide immediate assistance for the next natural disaster.

In order to help as many people as possible, the Diocese of Rapid City will take up a special collection for this during the month of October. I urge you to use this opportunity to express our solidarity and our loving support for our brothers and sisters in need.
