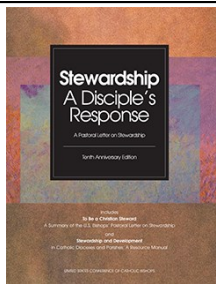

### **Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome**

"The two most important principles of Catholic social teaching are the sanctity of human life and the dignity of the human person. ...
