Thank you for helping to build a Future Full of Hope in the Diocese of Rapid City through your generous response to our 2025 Annual Diocesan Appeal.

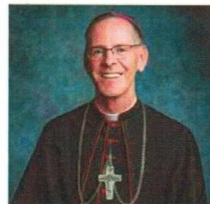

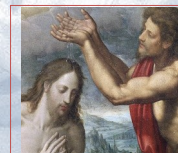
