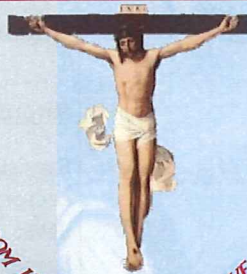

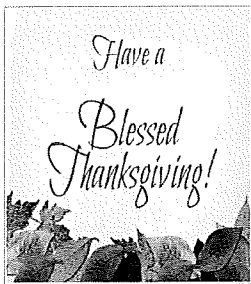

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

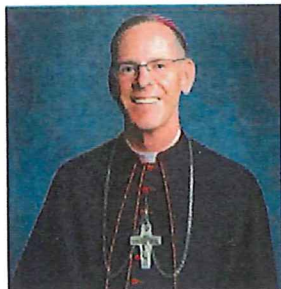
Thank you for accepting God's call to be *Messengers of Hope* in the Diocese of Rapid City through your generous response to our 2026 Annual Diocesan Appeal.
